## FutureLand

INFORMATION CENTER MAASVLAKTE 2



### Port number 8360

FutureLand is in the middle of the Maasvlakte, looking over the Maasvlakte 2, currently under development. All destinations in the port area have their own port number. These port numbers are indicated on the signs. For FutureLand, follow port number 8360.

### By car

#### Coming from Amsterdam / The Hague and Rotterdam / Utrecht

Coming from these directions, follow the A20 motorway via Kleinpolderplein in the direction of Hoek van Holland. At the Kethelplein, take the Beneluxtunnel (A4) towards Europoort. After the Beneluxplein and Botlektunnel (A15), follow the signs indicating port number: 8360. The A15 becomes the N15. Follow the brown signs 'FutureLand' above the road signs. After the traffic lights, you will see FutureLand on your left.

#### Coming from Gorinchem

After the Noordtunnel, proceed in the direction of Europoort (A15) via Ridderkerk Junction. After the Beneluxplein and Botlektunnel,

follow the signs indicating port number: 8360. The A15 becomes the N15. Follow the brown 'FutureLand' signs above the road signs. After the traffic lights, you will see FutureLand on your left.

#### Coming from Breda / Dordrecht

After the Drechtunnel, proceed in the direction of Europoort (A15) via Ridderkerk Junction. After the Beneluxplein and Botlektunnel, follow the signs indicating port number: 8360. The A15 becomes the N15. Follow the brown 'FutureLand' signs above the road signs. After the traffic lights, you will see FutureLand on your left.

### By bike using the Fast Ferry

During the summer FutureLand is easily accessible by bike. Take the RET Fast Ferry from Hoek van Holland to the Maasvlakte. From Antarcticaweg, it will take you about 20 minutes to cycle to FutureLand. From the Fast Ferry stop, cycle right down Antarcticaweg. Turn left at the end. After a few minutes, you will see FutureLand on your right.

The Fast Ferry is an experience in itself. On your way over, prepare to be amazed by the container giants and mammoth tankers that sail to and fro. The catamaran will get you to the Maasvlakte in fifteen minutes. Please note: during winter no departures take place at the middle of the day and not on weekends.
